Question: So I've been told by a few friends that I should have a pen name especially because of my last name. What are your thoughts?




Lots to Be Thankful For

The new cover for Ripples of Mind is done. (Yay!) I need to finish revisions and send it to my editor. (Wish me luck!)




My Comic Vlog this month is on NaNoWriMo. Gotta love a challenge as year's end approaches! ☺
