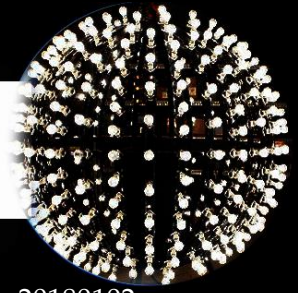

Question: How much did you spend on an editor?

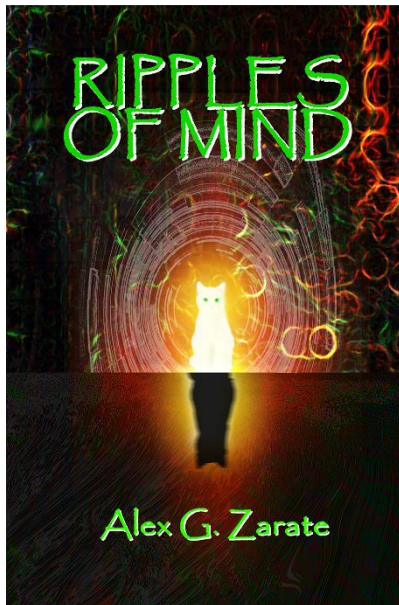

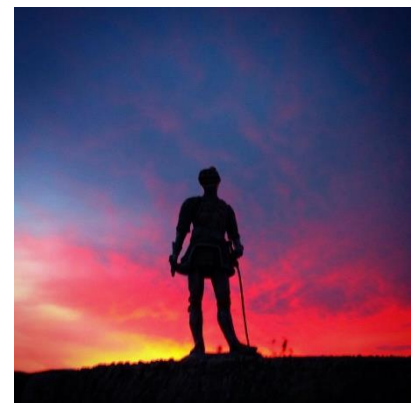
